

PARENT, FAMILY AND SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Let's be sure to keep this league about learning and fun!!! We ask that spectators encourage a sportsmanlike environment by showing positive support towards ALL players, coaches, and referees. For matters of clarification, the following rules are now in place and will be enforced:

1. Spectators are asked not to "coach" players from the stands at any time during the game, as this is disruptive to the players, coaches, and team. If you are interested in coaching, please fill out a coaching application on our website and volunteer your time next year.
2. Spectators are encouraged to cheer for the players and teams. However, no spectator may engage in any cheer against another player or team. Also, comments against a player, coach, referee, etc. regarding race, sex, or ability will not be tolerated. Furthermore, any use of profanity that is audible to the players, coaches, and referees, will not be tolerated, and is cause for ejection.
3. From this point forward, Cranston Youth Basketball Association will operate all events under a strict zero tolerance rule. Any spectator who is engaging in unsportsmanlike actions as described above is subject to immediate ejection from the facilities with or without warning. In the case that an ejection is to occur, the person must leave the facilities, immediately.
